As Bird Golf's West Coast flagship site, we are proud to be the official golf school of the Wild Horse Pass Resort. Wild Horse Pass has taken its place as one of the finest golf resort destinations in the Southwest. It is nestled between the Sierra Estrella and South Mountains. Enjoy the rugged, awe-inspiring vistas surrounding the resort and the golf courses. Wild Horse has something for everybody. The perfect Arizona resort setting.

The resort has been the recipient of several awards. 

Featuring 63 holes of championship golf, including The Pines, which is nationally recognized for its 27 championship holes, and has been the recipient of Golf Magazine's, Silver Medal as well as, in 2002, being rated by Golf Digest as Minnesota's only five-star course. ## Seaview Resort & Spa Galloway, New Jersey, 2 hours from NYC

It was created by Hall of Fame architect Gene Hamm who designed 36 holes of championship golf. The Grey Fox is considered by many to be one of the most difficult challenges in the area. It is also highlighted by several elevation changes which present you with panoramic views. The Red Fox Course is a local favorite, offering wide manicured fairways and large elevated fast rolling greens. Water comes into play on 6 holes; strategy rather than force will help your play through the stunning scenery that constantly surrounds you. You stay at the Homewood Suites in the town of Pinehurst. The Homewood Suites has a fitness center, swimming pool and business center and is close to an array of restaurants and shops. Your package includes a beautifully appointed 1- bedroom suite with a separate bedroom and living area.



## Oregon

## Eagle Crest Resort Redmond, Oregon, 30 minutes from Bend

Both courses also enjoy the distinction of being Audubon International certified. We have private practice areas and extensive short game facilities to practice and the beautiful, stately Clubhouse offers all the amenities of a private club. You stay at the adjacent Westin Hilton Head Island Resort and Spa, a luxury hotel immersed in the vivid natural beauty of the Carolina coast.
